ANNUAL BEER TOUR
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2010

It's 2010, so we are back in the city again....Manhattan that is. 2010 will be the 6th time we will visit NYC. As usual, my tour includes the bus service, lunch with a pint, and an "All You Can Eat and Drink Buffet". For lunch, I have reserved the **RADEGAST CAFE** in Williamsburg, Brooklyn. This facility is a typical beer/sausage pub as you would see in Germany. It's in the very hip neighborhood of Williamsburg, Brooklyn, located near many eclectic pubs, cafes and Brooklyn Brewery. I will be offering a traditional German lunch, consisting of your choice of either Bratwurst or Kielbasa. Accompaniments will be French Fries, Greens, Sauerkraut and one pint of Radegast's extensive German beer selection. The Radegast has bench seating in a very large beer garden, typical to Munich's Oktoberfest beer gardens. The evening dinner will be an all you can eat and drink buffet at **HEARTLAND BREWERY**, located on South Street across the street from the South Street Seaport complex on the Hudson River. Our arrival there at 5:30 pm should coincide very nicely in time for a scenic sunset over the Hudson, weather permitting. There are many cafes and shopping places at the Seaport facility.

8:30 am Pickup at the Commuter parking lot by John Harvard's Brewhouse, Manchester
11:30 am – 12:30-1:00pm Lunch at the **RADEGAST CAFE** in Brooklyn, NYC

You will have from the end of Lunch until 5:30 pm to explore Manhattan and Brooklyn's great beer bars. For me, it's the best part of the day. I've put together an updated map of great beer pubs, nearby. This year I've included the Williamsburg section of Brooklyn. To get to Brooklyn from Manhattan, take the "L" train from Grand Central or anywhere along 14th St. Take the first stop in Brooklyn at Bedford Ave. When you get there, ask around for directions to the pubs listed on my maps. There is a lot to see in Brooklyn. Manhattan is only a subway ride. A portable GPS is useful.

5:30 pm We will meet for the "**All You Can Eat and Drink**" buffet at **South Street Seaport Heartland Brewing Company**. Across the street from the Seaport. The restaurant is reserved for our party only. We will have three hours to eat, imbibe and whatever else that is legal to do in public, as long as you are civil and courteous.

8:30 pm Back on the bus for the ride home. Finish leftover beer lingering on the bus.
